Start out the 2003/2004 ski season with a great three or four-day weekend ski trip. Early December at Snowshoe can be fantastic or the trip could be canceled due to no snow. In some years, we have had as much as a 70" base; and on several occasions as much as 3 feet of new snow while we were skiing. No demo days or snowboard competition is scheduled, so crowds should not be a problem. We have the best location on the mountain - the Stemwinder condos - **ski-in/ski-out!** Prices are based on double occupancy. First come, first serve! Space based on availability of condos. After October 15th, we may not be able to get the condos that we need. **Sign Up Now!**

Mountain Facts: 180" average annual natural snowfall, elevation 4848', 11 lifts (2 high speed quads) 3 tows
57 slopes (31% green, 37% blue, 32% black), 1500' vertical, longest run - 1.5 miles, 100% snowmaking

PARTIES:- We will have a pre-trip party Sunday, November 27; a wine and cheese party on the mountain; and a spaghetti dinner Saturday night in the condos. Breakfast is provided on Saturday and Sunday mornings. And, as always, boxed beverages and munchies will be available through the weekend.

For the 9th year in a row we will be returning to the scenic Monarch Ski Area on the Continental Divide west of Colorado Springs, Co. The Monarch ski trip is easily the best attended club destination in the history of the club – with about 500 participants over the past 8 years.

Skiing:

The Monarch Ski Resort, at 10,790 ft., has the highest base elevation of any ski resort in Colorado and is thereby assured of very consistent, dry snow conditions. And, since Monarch is not heavily marketed, there are no crowds to destroy the serenity of the slopes or any new snowfall from the night before.

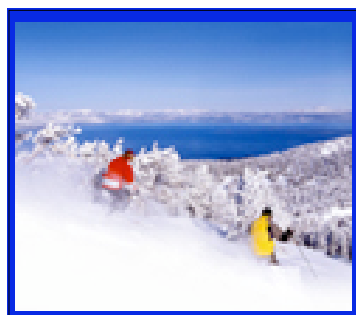



Tuesdays - Aldridge Creek - Meet at 5:15PM and leave at 5:30. The total length of the Greenway including the section along the Tennessee River is a little over 11 miles round trip and basically flat. This is the easiest and most scenic ride and is also suitable for bladders. There is a small park with parking/restrooms near the northern end of the greenway where we can meet. Directions are South on Memorial Pkwy, Left(E) on Weatherly Rd for 1.5 mi, Right(S) on Bailey Cove for 1.5 mi, Right(W) Mountain Gap. The park is on the left about one block from Bailey Cove on Mountain Gap.
