LAST CHANCE TO SIGN UP. WE GO SKIING TWO WEEKS AFTER THE NEXT SKI CLUB MEETING !!!

*Start out the 2003/2004 ski season with a great three or four-day weekend ski trip. Early December at Snowshoe can be fantastic or the trip could be canceled due to no snow. In some years, we have had as much as a 70" base; and on several occasions as much as 3 feet of new snow while we were skiing. No demo days or snowboard competition is scheduled, so crowds should not be a problem. We have the best location on the mountain - the Stemwinder condos - **ski-in/ski-out!** Prices are based on double occupancy. First come, first serve! Space based on availability of condos. After October 15th, we may not be able to get the condos that we need. **Sign Up Now!***

Cost/Payment schedule - \$10 sign-up fee, \$20 party fee, \$115 condo (dbl. occupancy), \$70 2-day lift ticket.

Payment Schedule - \$10 at sign-up, \$76 on Sept 15, \$76 on Oct. 20, \$75 on Nov. 17. **Total - \$215**

-Optional third day (Sunday) lift ticket add \$35. Optional extra night and ski day - stay Sunday night and ski Monday - add approximately \$90 for lodging and lift ticket (we decide when we get there).

Thanks for all your support. Please continue to send in your dues so we can keep your membership active.








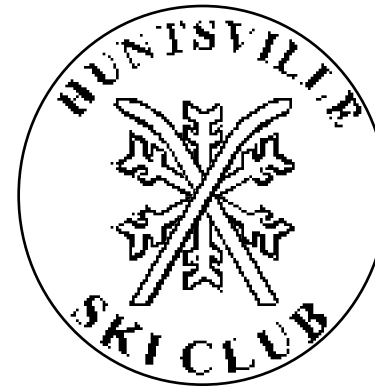
