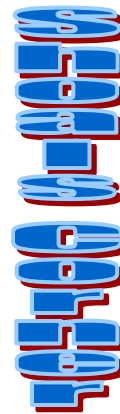
Membership Dues Past Due!!

HEAVENLY - SQUAW - NORTHSTAR

The Club flies into Reno on Saturday, 12 January and returns 9 day later on the MLK Monday, 21 January. We lodge for three nights in South Lake Tahoe at Lakeland Village and ski two days at Heavenly Ski Resort. On our third full day, we cruise northbound across Lake Tahoe on the Tahoe Queen paddle-wheeler to settle at Northstar-at-Tahoe for six nights lodging. On two days, we shuttle to ski Squaw Valley to ski. We ski three days at Northstar, where cross-country skiing is included in the lift ticket. Pre-trip add-ons are easy: Arrive 2 days early to lodge at Sierra Club's Clair Tappaan Hut for cross country skiing at Donner Pass. Or fly to Reno after work Friday, 11JAN, stay at the Sands, and ski Mt. Rose on Saturday until the club shows up.

Heavenly has the best views of the Lake Tahoe, beginner terrain at the top of the Gondola, steep backwoods ♦♦, and the highest and longest runs at Tahoe. Our Lakeland lodging has frequent, free shuttles around town (including casinos). **Northstar** has the friendliest village, gentle terrain, the most terrain parks, easy woodsy runs with wildlife if you look. It's a good place to try cross country skiing or snowboarding. Notice the two lodging options at Northstar. **Squaw Valley** has The Best backside for Big Air launches when the powder is deep. **Mt. 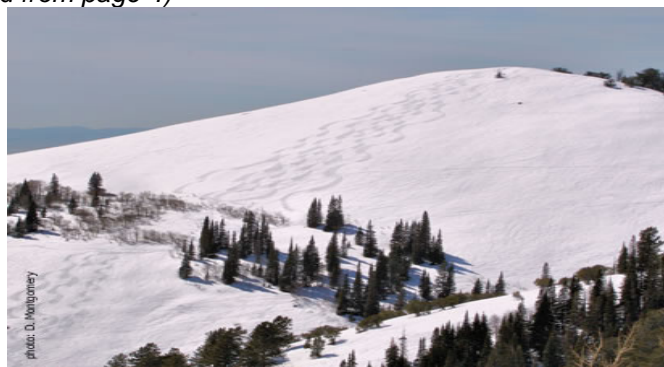

Web Notes

The HSC has now distributed **The Flakey News** for the past three months using the mass email capability of our web hosting service. This service allows use to email the entire membership having email service (317 emailed members) with one simple email message. Just to let the membership know, HSC can not do this easily from Comcast or Knology... There are still 13 members receiving the newsletter via snail mail only, and there are about 30 receiving it both email and snail mail. This same capability allows Sue Chatham to send out **HSC Alerts** to upcoming events—Sorry snail mail members.

Initially there were about seven members that did not receive the newsletter because of various problems (HSC had incorrect email

addresses; member's email service rejected the email, member's email address was not available). ..Now, after the first month we have one or two members that do not receive their newsletter for unknown reasons. Some ISPs (that is your email provider) block emails with large address list like ours because they are attempting to protect their customers from 'spam'. To prevent your ISP from blocking our email to you, you may need to 'White list' our email address with your ISP. All of this may sound complicated and can be for many. It is a 'cut and paste' exercise that we will handle on a case by case basis for those needing help....

...As we go through the new membership year this is a time to update information that HSC has to ensure you continue receiving the newsletter via email, snail mail, or both. The information that is kept by HSC is strictly guarded, never sold, never freely distributed in whole or in part. Limited membership information has been shared on the web site with other members in good standing to allow others to maintain contact with each other. You might find it interesting to note that we have over 400 members (single and all family members), and we have about the same number of single women and single men in the HSC.
