Greetings and Happy New Year 2021! We are still in the middle of our ski season but we need to start planning now what we want to do next season! The Crescent Ski Council decided on Sun Valley for their January (15 – 22) trip next year. We've had some talk in our club about a trip to the Park City area around the time of the Sundance festival. As you probably heard, our CSC trips to Steamboat and Telluride were cancelled. Per county regulation no more than one household is allowed in each condo. We are waiting to see if those restrictions will be lifted in time for our other trips. So far though, they are a GO.

Masks are a must, but we found that wearing a heavy neck warmer/gaiter covering your mouth and nose in the lift line was sufficient. Chair lifts were loaded with just your party and the attendants always asked if you were willing to take a single on your chair (we didn't take any gondolas so I don't know how those ran). The restaurants on the slope were open for take out only with seating out on the deck. There was an area set up inside (both at Breckenridge and Keystone) where you could sit to warm up (for 15 minutes) but you had to wear your mask the entire time and no eating or drinking was allowed. For the most part folks were pretty good about following the rules and the staff was very upbeat.

Purgatory has slopes for every level of skier from beginner to expert. The condos we have reserved have two full bedrooms with a king or queen bed in the master bedroom and two twins, a queen or king bed in the second bedroom, 1200 SQ FT.
