Hi to all Huntsvillians and friends! For the first time since I've been an HSC member, we are announcing our ski trips for the next season in May instead of June. This has allowed us to take advantage of lower pricing and availability for the trips we planned. Much planning has

transpired with our ski trips committee and we are excited about our planned ski destinations for the 2019-2020 season. A few details have yet to be determined, but there are sufficient details for us to release our selections now. Group air is still an unknown in some cases, but the ground packages and trip leader/coordinators are pretty firm. As you know, we cannot guarantee lots of snow like this past season, but we can guarantee you lots of fun when you ski with your HSC friends. Thanks to all our trip leaders and members that participated in the trips committee planning.

Details of all the HSC trips will be presented at our May club meeting but signups may not begin until the online registration capability is working. Signups for CSC trips will not open until 1 June. If you have thought about skiing two weeks next season, save yourself lots of dollars by purchasing an IKON pass. All of the HSC trips are at IKON resorts. For help and assistance in purchasing your IKON pass go to: www.sportsamerica.com/ikon-crescent. When you buy your pass with Sports America that qualifies you to receive either \$50 off your trip if you buy a FULL pass, or \$30 off your trip if you buy a BASE pass. As with last year, there will be a limited number of places available and the trips could fill up fast. So, sign up as soon as possible and assure you get the trip or trips you want for next season.

Steamboat has slopes for every level of skier from beginner to expert. The condos (The Phoenix) have 2 bedrooms and 2 baths and are only steps away from the slopes.
